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Quick Guide:

The Skill Acquisition Module is prepared so that an Individual would be properly equipped to commence production in the Skill of choice. The following are the guidelines explained:

Adoption, Incubation & Mentorship: This phase ensures a trainee is given the chance to know the ins and outs of the particular Skill. It will further ensure the trainee is well-prepared for the other phases.

Training: This phase involves the Skill learning process.

Production: This Phase involves applying the Skill and ensuring a trainee can apply what they learned during the training phase to produce a service (ICT/Photography and Cinematography) or products.
